**Explanation of Responses:**

1. The price reported is the average weighted price. The shares were purchased in multiple transactions. Mr. Alala disclaims beneficial ownership of any of the Capitala Finance Corp.'s (the "Issuer") shares directly held by Capitala Private Investments LLC, Capitala Restricted Shares I, LLC ("CRS"), Capitala Transaction Corp., CapitalSouth Corporation and Capitala Investment Advisors, LLC, except to the extent of his pecuniary interest therein, and this report shall not be deemed an admission that Mr. Alala is the beneficial owner of such securities for purposes of Section 16 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended, or any other purpose.

3. As of the date of this report, unvested Awards with respect to 505,479.08 shares of the Issuer's common stock held by CRS, which is controlled by Mr. Alala and is an affiliate of Capitala Investment Advisors, LLC (the "Adviser"), have been granted to certain of the Adviser's employees pursuant to CRS's Amended and Restated 2015 Equity Compensation Plan, dated September 18, 2015 (the "Plan"). Unvested Awards under the Plan are scheduled to vest as follows: 10% on September 25, 2016, 30% on September 25, 2017 and 40% on September 25, 2018. Upon settlement, the unvested Awards will become payable on a one-for-one basis in shares of the Issuer's common stock. The Plan was previously approved by the Issuer's Board of Directors. As of the date of this report, Mr. Alala holds unvested Awards with respect to 160,408.68 shares of the Issuer's common stock held by CRS.

4. Pursuant to the SEC staff no-action letter to Babson Capital Management LLC (pub. Avail. Dec. 14, 2006), an employee benefit plan sponsored by an investment adviser (or an affiliated person of an investment adviser) to a closed-end investment company regulated under the Investment Company Act of 1940, as amended, that offers plan participants equity securities of such investment company is considered an "employee benefit plan sponsored by the issuer" for the purposes of Rule 16b-3 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended.
